

Acceptable or Popular Profanity

“For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned”, Matthew 12:37.

That sets the seal on what has come from your mouth, whether it is profane or not, and if it is profane, whether it is generally acceptable or popular!

God’s Word, through Moses to the Chosen Race, is explicitly clear, “Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain”, Exodus 20:7.

To day, God’s Word, through the Bible to the Christians, is explicitly clear, “Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain”, Exodus 20:7.

God does not deem the ‘Christian’ who uses such language as redeemed, and definitely not in the family of God.

What is Profanity?

It is usually a form of language that takes God’s name in vain. It is also used to degrade others by using vile or vulgar language.

Some people find it acceptable, while others in the population use it as a popular part of their normal speech.

It Is Spreading.

A 2010 study on profanity by the American News & Parents Television Council found that TV profanity over the previous five years had increased by 70%.

Statistics show that public profanity has increased by hundreds of per cent.

Profanity is often clearly heard in public places.

Women and children are often heard using profanity without regard for those around them.

A Barna Research survey found 37% of the church people deemed the use of profanity morally acceptable!

If Christians listen to such language, how can 37% of church people claim they are saved!

Why is all this happening?

Listen to what Jesus said in Matthew 15:18–20, “But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man. For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies. These are the things which defile a man....”

Satan’s days are coming to a close. Anything he can use or do against God’s Commandments through God’s People – HE WILL ENDEAVOUR TO MAKE PROFANITY LOOK ATTRACTIVE AND POPULAR, BUT FOR THE CHRISTIAN, IT IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Profanity might be Popular, but it is not acceptable. The mouth is declaring a foolish heart, and the spiritual immorality of man!
